## INSTRUCTIONS FOR DELAYED BIRTH AND BIRTH CORRECTIONS

The following items of documentary evidence will be received and considered by the Court in entertaining applications to register omitted births or to correct an erroneous birth record, if such items tend to show the age and place of the applicant.

When the application is filed, the applicant must submit with his application:

- (a) At least one item of items numbered 1 to 3, inclusive together with one item of 4 to 15 or
- (b) If one item of items 1 − 3 is not available, then the applicant should submit at least three items numbered 4 − 15, with the application.

A fee of \$7.00 for registration of birth, \$5.00 for correcting a birth record.

- 1. Affidavit of parents or surviving parent.
- 2. Affidavit of one relative and one non-relative, or two non-relatives each of whom must be at least five years older than the applicant.
- 3. Certificate of attendant at birth.
- 4. Insurance policies of the applicant of at least ten years' standing whether in effect or not.
- 5. Original baptismal records.
- 6. Original entry in family Bible made within two years after birth.
- 7. Military or civil service records of at least ten years' standing.
- 8. Marriage record of applicant.
- 9. Birth record of one or both parents.
- 10. Birth record of child or children of applicant of at least ten years standing.
- 11. Official school record of applicant.
- 12. Union, lodge or fraternal record of applicant of at least ten years standing.
- 13. Certified copy of census record.
- 14. Naturalization record of parents.
- 15. Any other documentary evidence considered valid by the Judge.
